



## **Online & Mobile Security Tips from OCB**

- ✓ Do not use your Social Security number as a username or password. Change your usernames and passwords regularly and include combinations of letters, numbers and special characters, such as # and @.
- ✓ Protect your online passwords. Don't write them down or share them with anyone.
- ✓ Protect your answers to security questions.
- ✓ Use secure websites for transactions and shopping. Make sure internet purchases are secured with encryption to protect your account information. Look for "secure transaction symbols" such as a lock symbol or <https://...> in the address bar.
- ✓ Always completely log off from online banking and any website after using your debit or credit card.
- ✓ Be cautious when using public hotspots and review your auto-connect Wi-Fi settings on your mobile device.
- ✓ Frequently delete text messages from OCB and consider using a keypad lock on your mobile device.
- ✓ Ensure that your computer is virus-free with anti-virus and malware protection software.
- ✓ Use computer firewalls if available on your operating system.
- ✓ Consider using a malware scan and removal app on your mobile device.
